Research Professor at James Cook University (Queensland, Australia), former director of the School of Earth Sciences, former chairman of the Marine Science and Technologies Award Committee, and an overseas honorary fellow of the Royal Society of New Zealand.



LORD CHRISTOPHER MONCKTON

Third Viscount Monckton of Brenchley, chief policy advisor to the Science and Public Policy Institute. A British business consultant, journalist, and inventor, he served as an advisor to British Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher.

Geologist, former NASA astronaut, university professor, and U.S. Senator, the twelfth and last living person to walk on the Moon, and chairman of the NASA Advisory Council.
